Day 1 – Edmonton to Jasper

*Depart Edmonton at your leisure (approximately 3.5 hour drive. Keep in mind the National Park Fees are not included in your package (\$10 per person/day).

Arrival at the Astoria Hotel in Jasper townsite (check in time is 4:00pm). **Confirmation #:** _____. You will be required to supply a credit card or cash deposit upon check-in for any incidentals. Please note: All of the guest rooms are accessible only by stairs (one flight) and there is no elevator. After check-in enjoy your included well-deserved cold beverage at the De'd Dog Bar & Grill (located in the lobby area of the hotel).

Day 2 – Jasper Canoe Tour

8:15am Please arrive at Pyramid Lake Resort – 6kms North on Pyramid Lake Road to meet your guide for your Sunburst Canoe Adventure Tour (their large canoe will be on the beach of Pyramid Lake) which starts at 8:30am. **Confirmation #:** _____. This 'Sunburst' Canoe Adventure is a perfect way to start your day! You will paddle with your guide on the peaceful waters of Pyramid Lake. It's a great time of day to possibly see some wildlife. This tour will be approximately 3.5 hours. All necessary paddling and safety equipment will be provided along with beverages and snacks. Please bring phones/cameras and warm layers!

Directions:

1. Head southwest out of town on Connaught Drive (Hwy 16a)
2. Cross the Yellowhead Highway (Hwy 16)
3. Continue south onto the Icefields Parkway (Hwy 93)
4. Cross over a small bridge in 500m and soon there are signs for Jasper Skytram
5. Turn right onto Whistlers Road and follow the road up the mountain to the end of the road

How to Prepare for your visit:

Mask - masks are mandatory when inside the tram car. Please bring your own, or purchase on arrival.

Camera - capture the best views in Jasper

Clothing - dress in layers & hiking footwear

*Event is weather-permitting. In the event the skies are clouded over, an extended indoor portion will take place at the Upper SkyTram Station and we'll have the chance to explore the Athabasca River Valley (including the town of Jasper) through our telescopes on the mountain. SkyTram Upper Station is usually 10 ° cooler than in town as it is 1000 metres higher than Jasper, so bring warm layers to enjoy the outdoor stargazing portions of the evening.

*Blast off with astronomy experts from The Jasper Planetarium for an exclusive dining and stargazing experience atop the Jasper Skytram. Your SkyTram flight will take you nearly 1 km closer to the stars above, to the Skytram Upper Station, where you'll have the chance to look through the most powerful telescopes in the Canadian Rockies under the darkest skies in the Rockies.

Join a guided tour of the Solar System, learning about planets, galaxies, and constellations, and if you're lucky, you might even see a meteor or the Northern Lights! You'll also have a chance to attend a special talk on Canada's dark skies or a quick workshop about how to photograph objects in the night sky with your DSLR camera.

*Dinner includes a choice of one of 3 individualized platters and includes drink and dessert.

9:30pm-10:30pm Return flights back down the mountain.

Day 3 – Jasper to Edmonton – Wednesday, August 12/20

**Breakfast is included (\$10 value voucher) at the hotel at your leisure before you check out and pay any incidentals. Check-out time is 11:00am. Breakfast starts at 7:00am each day until 11:30am.*
