Arrival

Marmot Basin Ski Resort

*Most Lifts/runs are open from 9am to 4pm.

*Marmot Basin is using RFID lift cards replacing paper lift tickets. These RFID cards cannot be fastened to clothing and should be secured in a pocket on the left side of your ski jacket (outside sleeve pocket is best). Make sure your phone or wallet is not in the same pocket as your RFID lift card. You may to take a picture of your RFID card. Any issues or problems with your RFID card please visit Group Sales. At the end of the last day please return all your used RFID cards to the Tour Director.

*No outdoor food is permitted inside their facilities. Table seating is reserved for paying customers other than in Jim's Den Chalet at mid-mountain.



Optional non-ski activities:

Maligne Canyon Icewalk Tour – Saturday 9:30am (34 spots) or 1:30pm (10 spots) – tour will take about 3 hours, first come first serve.

The Maligne Canyon Icewalk Tour is one of Jasper's most popular and impressive winter adventures. Your trained SunDog tour guide will take you to the bottom of the Maligne Canyon – the deepest accessible canyon in Jasper National Park – where you will explore frozen waterfalls, ice caves, and incredible ice formations. You will learn about Jasper's Maligne Valley, Karst topography, and the mystery of the "disappearing" Medicine Lake.

The tour covers approximately 3.5 kms (2.1 miles) and is mostly downhill. Participants are required to dress appropriately for the weather. Pick-up and drop-off will be from your hotel. Shoe sizes are required as ice cleats will be provided along with helmets.

*Please be prepared for the mountain weather. It changes quickly and winter tours run up to -25C (-17F). Wind chill can change the temperature dramatically and you will be outside for the majority of your tour. To ensure that you enjoy the tour, please wear/bring:

-Thermals / base layers / long johns, warm sweater, warm jacket, hat and warm mitts/gloves and a neck warmer or scarf.

-Snow pants are recommended for this tour and are mandatory if it is below -16C (3F). Otherwise, on warmer days, jeans / regular pants over long johns are okay.

This excursion is weather dependent, we will confirm any changes 24 hours prior to departure.

Snowshoe Tour – 36 spots for Sunday at 11:00am – tour will take about 2 hours, first come first serve: The Snowshoe Tour offers an exciting way to discover Jasper National Park in the winter. Our knowledgeable guides are well versed in the history, geology, and ecology of the area and will provide commentary as you explore the mountain wilderness, search for animal tracks, and listen for the song of the chickadee. Please dress for the weather – similar to attire for the Icewalk Tour above.
