\*Marmot Basin will now be using RFID lift cards replacing paper lift tickets. These RFID cards cannot be fastened to clothing and should be secured in a pocket on the left side of your ski jacket (outside sleeve pocket is best). Make sure your phone or wallet is not in the same pocket as your RFID lift card. We suggest that you take a picture of your RFID card if possible. \*A warm sweater, warm jacket, hat, mitts/gloves and neck warmer/scarf.

The Maligne Canyon Icewalk Tour is one of the most popular and impressive Jasper winter adventures. Your trained SunDog tour guide will take you to the bottom of the Maligne Canyon – the deepest accessible canyon in Jasper National Park – where you will explore frozen water falls, ice caves, and incredible ice formations. You will learn about Jasper's Maligne Valley, Karst topography, and the mystery of the "disappearing" Medicine Lake.

This Jasper icewalk tour is a great option for anyone who does not ski or snowboard. The tour covers approximately 3.5 kms (2.1 miles) and is mostly downhill. Participants are required to dress appropriately for the weather. Please indicate your shoe size when booking as warm boots ice cleats will be provided.
