These RFID cards cannot be fastened to clothing and should be secured in a pocket on the left side of your ski jacket (outside sleeve pocket is best). Make sure your phone or wallet is not in the same pocket as your RFID lift card. We suggest that everyone take a picture of the front and back of their RFID card if possible. \*\*No outdoor food is permitted inside their facilities. Table seating is re-served for paying customers. Other than in Jim's Den Chalet at mid-mountain.

There are lots of options for lunch on the hill – the upper lodge has a cafeteria, and the Eagles nest lounge sometimes has an outdoor BBQ and firepit if the weather is good. Lower mountain main lodge has a large cafeteria and there is also a lounge there, Caribou Bar and Grill, with a full menu that is quite tasty.

- 5:00pm** Quick stop at the Jasper Park Lodge to pick up other guests.

### For those going to the Jasper Park Lodge:

- 10:15am** Bus will be available for boarding at the Chateau Jasper outside the front lobby.
- 10:30am** Bus departs for Jasper Park Lodge.
- 10:45am** Arrival at Jasper Park Lodge. Please check-in at the Health Club & Pool, located on the lower level of the main lodge. You will then receive your gift certificate.
- 5:00pm** Bus arrives for pick up back to the Chateau Jasper.

### For those doing the Jasper Downtown Foodie Tour:

- 2:15pm** Arrival at the Visitor Information Center (500 Connaught Drive) to Check-in for the Downtown Foodie Tour. \*Please note that transportation is not provided to the Visitor Information Center.
