## Day 4- Sunday

# Banff Gondola (included): open 9am to 8pm

Witness breathtaking alpine views and keep your eyes peeled for grizzly bears and other local wildlife from the Lake Louise Summer Gondola!

## Lake Louise site seeing opportunity (parking fee not included \$36.97):

Begin with the lakeshore trail along the water, pausing to take in a tall waterfall and fearless rock climbers. Glacial creeks converge at the far end of the lake, and every shade of blue imaginable melds together just beyond the shoreline.

#### Moraine Lake recommendation:

Take a pit stop at this free attraction. This stunning turquoise lake, cradled by the Valley of the Ten Peaks is a must-see attraction.



#### Banff upper hot springs (included): open 10am to 10pm

What better way to complete your trip than for a soak in Banff National park's greatest tradition. 100% natural mineral water is flowing at the Banff Upper Hot Springs. Relax in the outdoor pool among the jagged peaks of Rundle and Cascade Mountains is a magical experience that has drawn visitors to Banff since 1886.
